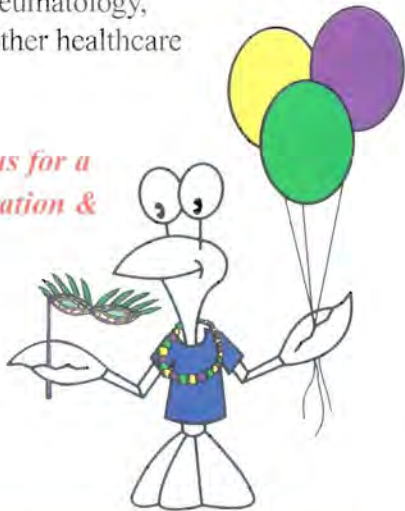
1:00 p.m. — Opening Ceremonies

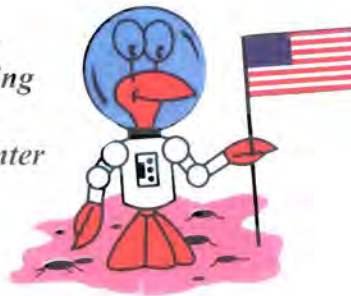
